Discussion:

Term Verification: Larry brought up that there may be a discrepancy regarding terms of Planning Board members. Comprehensive Plan:

The public poll will be shorter than the previous one and will include those residents residing in the trailer park and apartment complexes. There was some discussion surrounding talking to the High School about students helping in the door to door poll a part of government project.
