Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Mayor Gary Baker

Discussion was held regarding contaminated soil at the Lake Plant. During the recent removal of an underground fuel oil tank, it was discovered that the tank had leached fuel oil into the soil.

After conferring with the DEC it was decided that the Village would hire an excavator to remove the soil. The Village of Wolcott would haul the soil to the Wastewater Treatment Plant. There the soil would be dumped into the drying beds. Manure would be added to the soil and then rototilled on a regular basis for approximately 6 months. At which time the soil should be deemed safe and would be able to be used as fill.

Mr. Norsworthy was asked to obtain a proposal from LaValley Brothers for excavation of the site.

A motion to adjourn was made at 8:06 by Trustee Smith and seconded by Trustee Skinner. All voted in favor.
